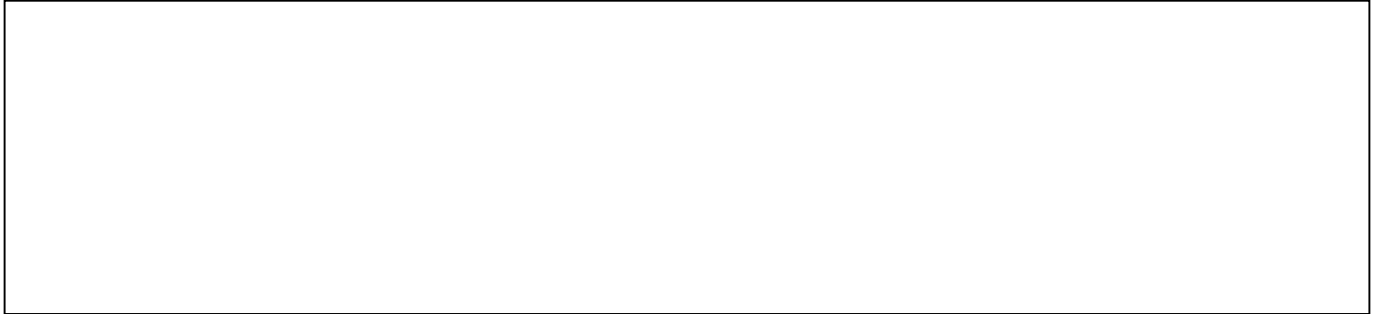

6-1 How Many People Can the Earth Support?


- Human Pop Growth Continues But is Unevenly Distributed

- Women Are Having Fewer Babies but Not Few Enough...




- The US Population is Growing Rapidly

● The US: A Nation of Immigrants



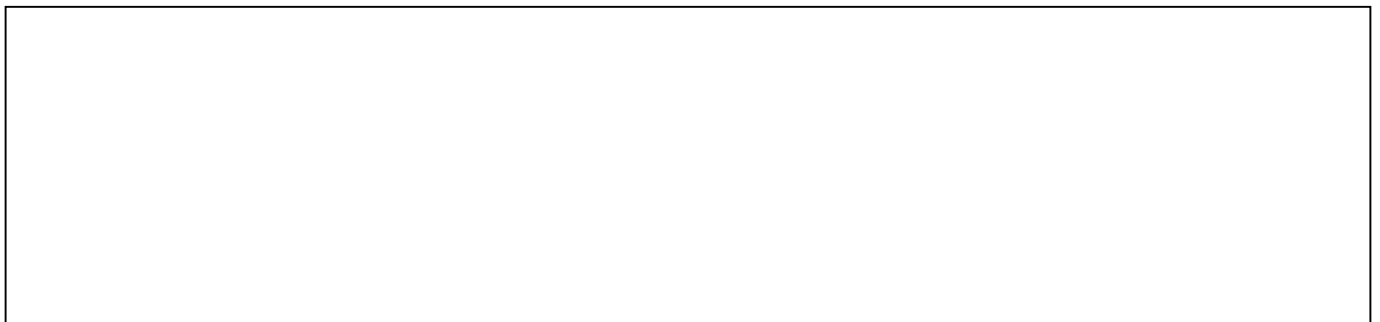
6-3 How Does a Population's Age Structure Affect Its Growth or Decline?

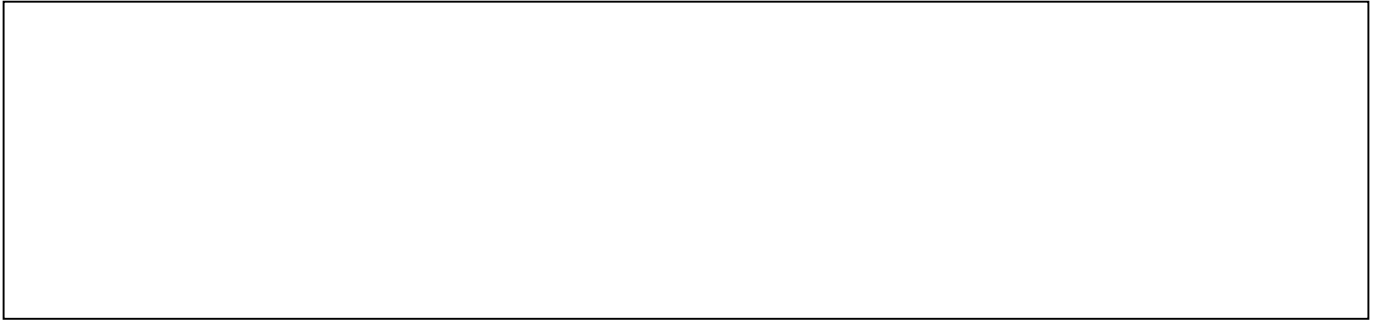
- The American Baby Boom

- First Step – Promote Economic Development

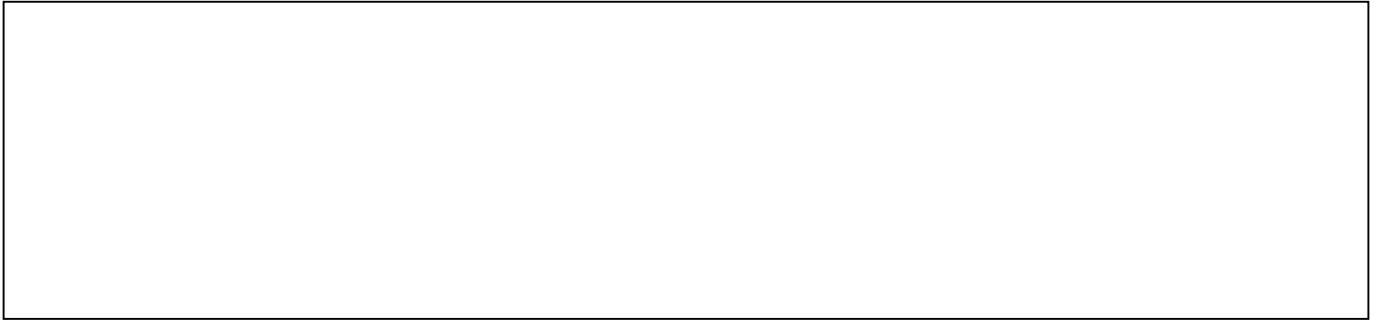
